Frequently asked questions about Implants:

What is an implant?

A dental implant is a titanium screw or post that is placed in the jaw bone to recreate the root of a missing tooth. More than one implant can be placed. A crown, bridge or denture is then attached to the implant or implants.

It is an excellent way to replace a gap or missing tooth or teeth when a denture or bridge may not be the ideal solution. They can also be used to stabilise dentures.

How long does it take?

Following a consultation, a treatment plan is agreed. Placing the implant usually takes between 1 to 2 hours. It can take between 3 to 6 months for the bone to heal before completion of treatment. Sometimes a denture is worn during this time.

Does it hurt?

Most people are pleasantly surprised to find that there is minimal pain after implant placement. We offer sedation to those patients who might want to be less aware of the treatment.

How much does it cost?

Each case is individual and you will be given a detailed estimate at your consultation. However, implants start at £2000 each, there is also a treatment planning fee of around £210. Other costs may be incurred such as a temporary denture, bone grafting or sedation.

How can I pay for it?

The cost of treatment is divided into 2 parts; a payment at implant placement and one on completion. Alternatively, we can offer interest-free finance which can spread the cost over 10 to 12 months.
